On Sunday 18th June 2023 The Dean of the Chapels Royal, the Rt Revd Dame Sarah Mullally preside at the Confirmation Service.

Confirmation is a sacramental rite of passage and is the way in which an individual strengthens and deepens their relationship with God. There are three principle actions in the confirmation service: The **presentation of the candidate**, at which point in the service the candidates awaiting confirmation are summoned to stand before the bishop; the **renewal of baptismal vows**, at which point the candidates renew the promises made at their baptism; and the **laying on of hands**, when the candidates being confirmed kneel before the bishop, who reads out the candidate's chosen confirmation name.

I am thrilled that we have three adult confirmands so far. If you would like to be confirmed this year, then please drop in a line and we can plan by the end of January 2023.
